

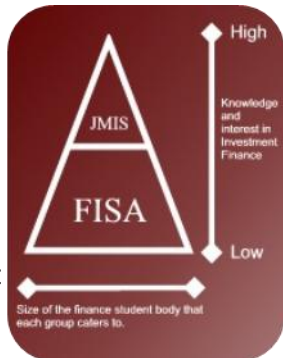

JMIS Portfolio

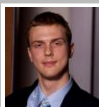
